10 ELIGIBILITY		The tournament is open to all Pan American National Olympic Committees that did not already qualified to the Pan Am Games Lima 2019, which can enter the players through the ITTF members Associations concerned. All players shall be eligible to represent their NOC in the Pan American Games according to the Pan Am Sports and the ITTF regulations (ITTF Handbook 4.5).
11 ENTRY & ACCREDITATION		11.1 Each Association is entitled to enter up to a maximum of two (2) men and two (2) women players. 11.2 The entry form must be returned to the FNTMG no later than 30th April 2019. The Organizer must be advised of any changes / substitutions no later than 21st May 2019, after this deadline no substitution or change of player is allowed. 11.3 Copy of passport and photograph of each participant must be sent to the Organizer and ITTF Competition Manager together with the Entry Form by following means: OC Email: guatemala.tt@gmail.com ITTF CM Email: Email
12 SYSTEM OF PLAY		All matches will be best of 7 games. Each session, one KO draws "blue and red" per gender will be played. For draw purposes, blue and red draws will be considered the top and bottom half of the same draw. The first two players from each NOC winning a "blue" or "red" KO draw will qualify to compete at the Pan American Games Lima 2019 On the last day, up to 6 reserves shall be determined. Draw One: Players will be drawn according to the last available ITTF World Ranking. Separation by ranking and by association will be applied. Draw Two: Players will be drawn according to the results of the Draw one and the ITTF World Ranking. The two losers in the finals of "red" and "blue" KO1 will be seeds 1 & 2. The two highest ranked semi-finalist in "red" and "blue" KO1 will be seeds 3 & 4. The two lowest ranked semi-finalist in "red" and "blue" KO1 and the the two highest losers in the quarter-finals of draws "red" and "blue" will be seeds 5 to 8. The same system will be used to determine the remaining seeded players. Draw Three: Players will be drawn according to the results of the Draw two and the ITTF World Ranking. The two losers in the finals of "red" and "blue" KO2 will be seeds 1 & 2. The two highest ranked semi-finalist in "red" and "blue" KO2 will be seeds 3 & 4. The two losers in the finals of "red" and "blue" KO2 will be seeds 3 & 4. The two lowest ranked semi-finalist in "red" and "blue" KO2 will be seeds 3 & 4. The two lowest ranked semi-finalist in "red" and "blue" KO2 will be seeds 3 & 4. The two lowest ranked semi-finalist in "red" and "blue" KO2 will be seeds 3 & 4. The same system will be used to determine the remaining seeded players. Note that as in KO1 and KO2 places 3-4 are not played, a loser in semi-finals of the blue or red draw will be considered as finishing in position 3 of that particular draw. Participants release all rights, or rights held by their agents or sponsors, in all matters relating to television and web casting coverage, video and motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. A participant's refusal of above listed coverage may be subject to suspension or dismissal from the competition.
